

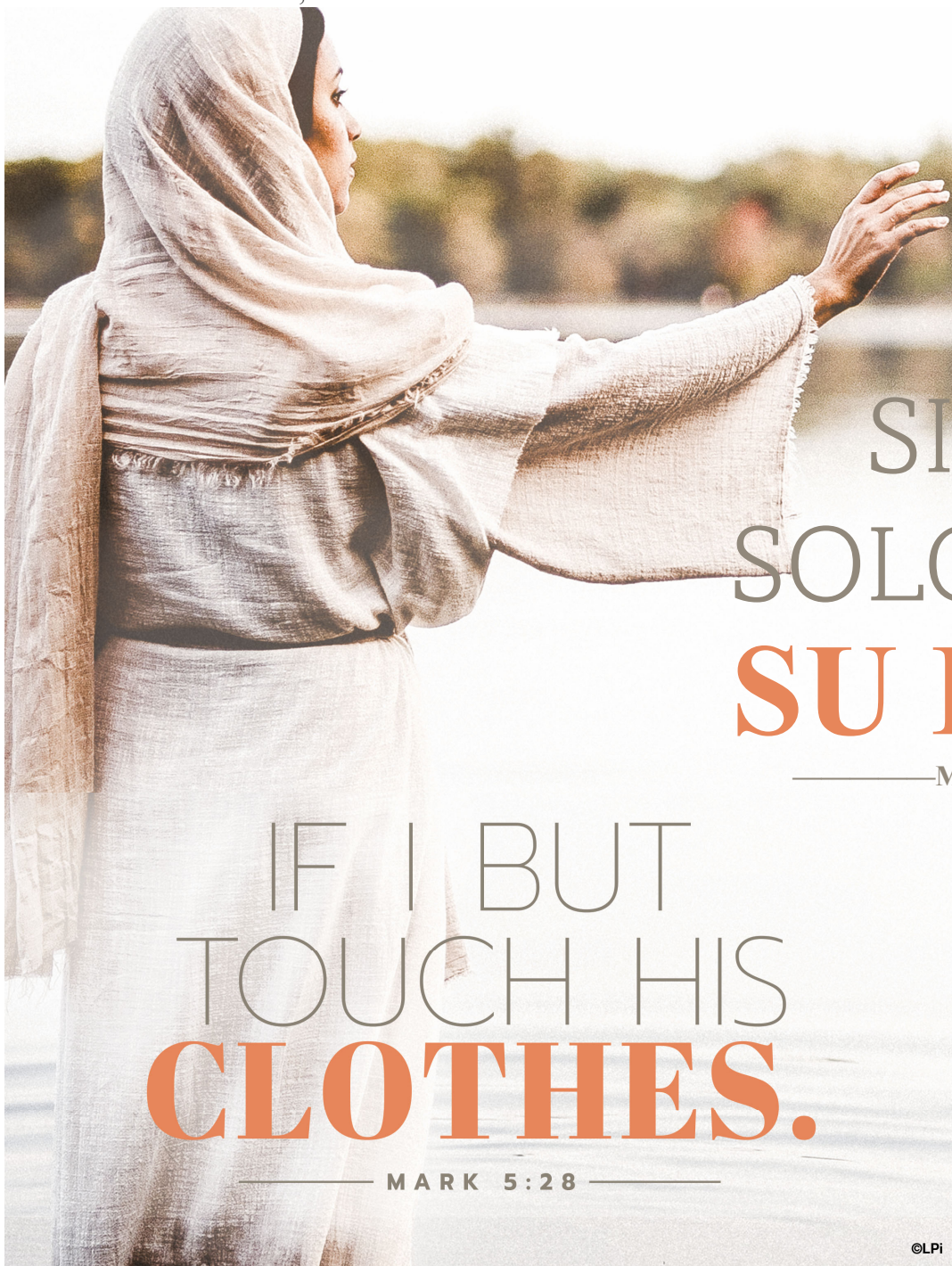

## **Boletim Paroquial Português**

**30 de Junho de 2024 – Domingo XIII do Tempo Comum**

**Reflexão Por: João Pereira Arruda**

O Evangelho de hoje traz-nos o relato de dois milagres feitos por Jesus. A mulher que jorrava sangue por doze anos e a filha de Jairo de doze anos que haveria acabado de morrer. O número doze na bíblia desde o Velho Testamento como no Novo Testamento tem um significado de grande relevância como tem em comum que nos dois casos Jesus ao fazer os milagres transformou a impureza em vida limpa. No tempo de Jesus o povo israelita considerava as pessoas que estavam mortas como as que jorravam sangue de serem impuras e consequentemente quem as tocasse ficaria impuro. Jairo, homem de fé e chefe da sinagoga, as suas orações e sacrifícios não livrou a filha da morte e a morte era sinal de impureza e por assim ser ninguém tocava numa pessoa morta; porém Jairo, homem de fé, esta levou-o a Jesus porque estava consciente de que só Jesus tinha a solução para trazer de novo à vida a filha. Do mesmo modo a mulher com hemorragias de sangue, a sua fé levou-a a Jesus que estava certa que bastava tocar na orla da túnica de Jesus para ficar curada. A grande fé de Jairo e da mulher na sua fé estavam certos que só Jesus tinha o poder de acabar com a impureza e transformar-la em vida nova e limpa. Na Primeira Leitura do Livro da Sabedoria, este diz-nos: “Foi pela inveja do diabo que a morte entrou no mundo e experimentam-na aqueles que lhe pertencem.” Se assim estava escrito nos livros antigos, não traz estranheza de que os israelitas consideravam a morte e hemorragias de sangue sinal de impureza e deste modo, causa para as pessoas em questão não serem tocadas. Jesus é a fonte da pureza e transformador da morte para a vida. Assim o O era no tempo que esteve entre nós encarnado; assim O é hoje com a sua presença na Santa Eucaristia e assim O é no Sacramento da Penitência no qual recebemos o perdão dos nossos pecados; (as nossas hemorragias de sangue) curados pela Sua infinita misericórdia. Deste modo as leituras deste Domingo dão-nos indicações precisamos ser guiados pela fé em direção a Jesus. A nossa Igreja dá-nos pelos sacramentos e pela doutrina as soluções para remos limpos das impurezas que obtemos no percurso das nossas vidas. Recorde-se que o Livro da Sabedoria também nos diz: “Deus criou o homem para ser incorruptível e fê-lo à imagem da sua própria natureza.”. E assim é, porque pelo nosso baptismo ficamos a ser filhos de Deus, somos chamados a sermos santos, profetas e sacerdotes e tudo isso nos livra de impurezas e de males. Porque não foi Deus quem fez o mal, nem Ele se alegra com a perdição dos vivos, dá-nos a força de poder-mos ir em direção a Jesus para ser afectivo na ajuda das dificuldades da vida.

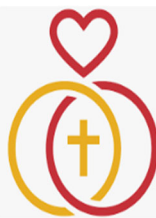
