From Monsignor Fran Cilia

This weekend, there is an interesting interplay between the readings from the Letter of James and the Gospel of Mark.

At Caesarea Philippi, Jesus asks his disciples what they hear from others and what they themselves believe about His identity. After the expected responses, Peter professes Jesus as “the Christ.” This watershed moment in the ministry of Jesus is followed immediately by Jesus’ first prediction of the Passion: “The Son of Man must suffer greatly and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests, and the scribes, and be killed, and rise after three days.”

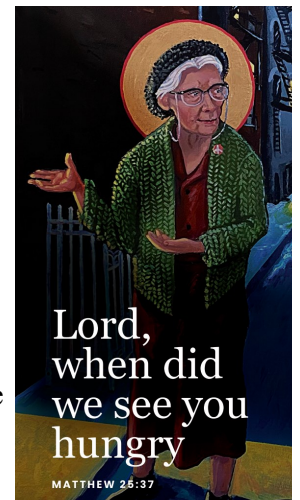
Who Jesus is (the Christ) determines what Jesus will do (suffer, die and rise). For Him, there was no alternative, but the faithful carrying out of the mission He had undertaken.

The Letter of James clarifies the relation between faith and what we call “Christian living”: “Faith of itself, if it does not have works, is dead.” To profess faith, to be a believer, even to be the Christ, has necessary consequences, the living out of one’s identity in the ways we live.

Jesus could not avoid suffering and death. Can His followers expect lives any easier?

Thank you, Catechists!

On Catechetical Sunday, we are happy to recognize, thank and commission our catechists who serve in our school and parish. Since their ministry is offered in your name, it is good that we are able to support them with our prayer and express our gratitude for the service they offer in our name: faith formation for the young, sacramental preparation (Eucharist, Reconciliation, Confirmation) for parish children and youth, Rite/Order of Christian Initiation for Children and Adults who seek membership with the Church, youth ministry, and the teaching of religion in our school classrooms week in and week out.



Quarterly Stewardship Collection

Our Quarterly Stewardship Collection is being taken up this weekend. The Spanish word for “stewardship” gives us a unique insight to the meaning of that word in our Christian vocabulary. That word is “corresponsabilidad.” The best English rendering of this is along the lines of “shared responsibility,” which is exactly what the Stewardship Collection is about; we share our responsibilities with one another for the spiritual, financial, and outreach work of the parish. Thank you for doing what you can to help us at this time of some major unexpected expenses related to the structural integrity of our buildings, at this time, particularly the rectory/parish office.



Boletim Paroquial Português **15 de Setembro de 2024, Domingo XXIV do Tempo Comum -B; Festa de Santa Cecília** **Reflexão Por: João Pereira Arruda**

A Primeira Leitura do Livro de Isaías, é quase sempre usada nas cerimónias de Sexta feira Santa. O Profeta Isaías muitos anos antes de Jesus vir ao mundo já profetizava o que iria acontecer-Lo na Sua paixão e morte. A Segunda Leitura S. Tiago continua a nos dizer, tal como nos últimos dois Domingos que a fé sem obras não tem validade nenhuma. A fé das pessoas tem que produzir feitos de melhoramente no mundo, efeitos de radicalmente mudar o mudo para melhor donde a justiça e a equidade produzem um mundo de paz e de amor. No Evangelho de hoje de S. Marcos, este revela que seguir a Jesus requer que cada um carregue a sua própria cruz. Jesus provou os Apóstolos perguntando o que se dizia dele afora do círculo em que Ele e os Apóstolos viviam. As grandes firmas comerciais, também pagam a firmas para fazerem pesquisas do que se fala do producto que eles oferecem. Qualquer informação que viesse de fora do Seu círculo de vida não iria mudar o seu rumo de caminhada para a salvação mas serviu para testar os próprios Apóstolos para dizerem o que Ele era para eles. Pedro impetuosamente diz: “Tu és o Messias”. Falava ele por si e pelos outros Apóstolos; mas tomando Jesus á parte avisa-O que como Messias de modo nenhum Ele poderá padecer e morrer. Severamente Jesusm Jesus repreende-o dizendo: “Retira-te satanás!” Falando assim que enquanto vivendo no mundo está para seguir o plano de Deus. Enquanto no mundo diz-nos Jesus, aqui e agora, que neste mundo devemos viver alerta escolhendo e fazendo as coisas que são de Deus. Sabe-se quais são as coisas de Deus quando melhor conhecemos a Deus pela oração e boas obrase fazendo isso o Espírito Santo de Deus está connosco e nos guia.

Santa Cecília em que celebramos neste Domingo, sendo ela escolhida pela nossa Sociedade Filarmónica e o nosso Grupo Coral como sua padroeira, fez as escolhas de vida voltada para Deus. Este fin de semana hay una interesante interacción entre las lecturas de la Carta de Santiago y el Evangelio de Marcos.

En Cesarea de Filipo, Jesús pregunta a sus discípulos qué escuchan de los demás y qué creen ellos mismos acerca de Su identidad. Después de las respuestas esperadas, Pedro profesa a Jesús como “el Cristo”. Este momento decisivo en el ministerio de Jesús es seguido inmediatamente por la primera predicción de Jesús sobre la Pasión: “El Hijo del Hombre debe sufrir mucho y ser rechazado por los ancianos, los sacerdotes y los escribas, y ser ejecutado, y resucitar después de tres días”.

Quién es Jesús (el Cristo) determina lo que Jesús hará (sufrir, morir y resucitar). Para Él no había otra alternativa que el fiel cumplimiento de la misión que había emprendido.

La Carta de Santiago aclara la relación entre la fe y lo que llamamos “vida cristiana”: “La fe en sí misma, si no tiene obras, está muerta”. Profesar la fe, ser creyente, incluso ser el Cristo, tiene consecuencias necesarias: vivir la propia identidad en la forma en que vivimos.

Jesús no pudo evitar el sufrimiento y la muerte. ¿Pueden sus seguidores esperar una vida más fácil?


