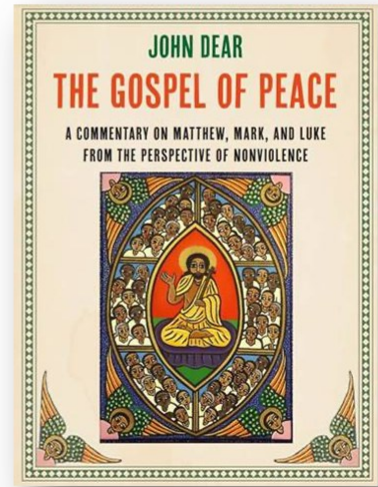

Boletim Paroquial Português

29 de Setembro de 2024 – Domingo XXVI do Tempo Comum Dia Mundial do Migrante e Refugiado

Reflexão Por: João Pereira Arruda

Mundialmente a nossa igreja dedica este Domingo às migrações e aos refugiados. Está esta temática ligada com a mensagem que vamos escutar na Primeira Leitura e no Evangelho: “ Se não são contra Mim são por Mim:” . Vem isto a propósito de que pelo Baptismo todos nós somos chamados a serem: sacerdotes, profetas e reis. Quer isto dizer também que ninguém tem o monopólio de representação. Todos têm direito a pregar, a evangelizar o amor de Deus para com todos os povos da terra. Não há nenhuma raça, ou civilização que tenha Deus por seu seu exclusivo. A visita dos Magos ao Menino Jesus confirmaram a vontade de Deus de ser o Deus de todos os povos da terra. Lembremo-nos neste Domingo que o amor de Deus é imensamente misericordioso que dá para amar todos nós e ainda cresce, porque o amor de Deus não tem limites. Lembremo-nos daqueles que se foram queixar a Moisés e a Jesus que outros estavam a profetizar em Seu Nome, a resposta de Moisés e de Jesus foi clara : se são por Mim estão adentro do que Eu espero deles. No mundo em que vivemos as migrações e os refugiados têm ganhado notoriedade nas redes sociais de informação ou até nas redes de comunicação sejam estas: pelas divulgadas pela rádio, jornais, TV, ou Internet. Todos têm a sua opinião. Cada opinião apanha os mal informados de Deus a usarem de opiniões contrárias às de Deus. Partindo do ponto em que o próprio Jesus foi exilado no Egípto para ser protegido da preseguição de Herodes, coube aos pais, S. José e Maria de migrarem para uma terra desconhecida. No Egípto tiveram que trabalhar para a sua sustentabilidade e como todos os migrantes quando vivendo em terras estrangeiras de acolhimento aceitam qualquer trabalho que se lhes aparece. Não se sabe muito de como os migrantes e refugiados eram vistos e tratados nos países de acolhimento por falta de meios de comunicação, mas sabemos que os refugiados choravam pela sua terra natal nas margens dos rios da Babilónia. Quer isto dizer que há razões muito fortes para saírem dos seus países de origem sejam elas, por falta de oportunidades para famílias carentes de bens essenciais para viverem, seja por falta de oportunidades de crescimento pessoal para um melhoramento de vida, seja por comportamentos de governos, de comportamentos opressores nos cidadãos que criticam as suas ideologias; tudo isso são razões válidas para mudanças de lugar e de vida para os exilados e migrantes. A situação nos Estados Unidos é diferente da Europa mas as duas partes do mundo comungam de uma visão negativa acerca dos imigrantes. E do impacto que estes trazem á sociedade dos países que os acolherem. Nesta nação sabe-se do que se fala dos migrantes: De mau carácter, ladrões, rapistas, e até mais recentemente de comerem animais de estimação. Na actualidade nada disso é verdade e para continuarem a tratar mal os migrantes e exilados criarem esta situação de migrantes legais e ilegais o que resulta em haver grandes crimes contra os imigrantes. Para este Domingo façamos um exame de consciência partindo do conceito de que para Deus não há ilegalidade, os migrantes e exilados tem direito a serem tratados com o conceito de aceitação e hospitalidade que as diferenças sejam oportunidades de crescimento e de aprendizagem de vida, porque assim também foi a Sagrada Família no Egípto. Que posição tenho e contribuo nas medidas que são feitas em desfavor de migrantes e exilados? Não pode haver exitação, ou és por Deus ou contra Ele.

Noite de Candidatos! O Portuguese American Forum de Santa Clara em cooperação com as organizações portuguesas de Santa Clara levam a efeito no salão da SES um fórum político no qual os candidatos a posições de governo local irão debater os seus portfólios nessa tarde de 17 de Outubro próximo. É de máxima importância que todos nós venham participar nesta actividade que ao longo dos anos tem trazido muitos benefícios á nossa comunidade. Mais detalhes em próximos boletins.

María, envuelve a nuestros sacerdotes con tu manto e intercede por su fortaleza y fidelidad a la Iglesia.

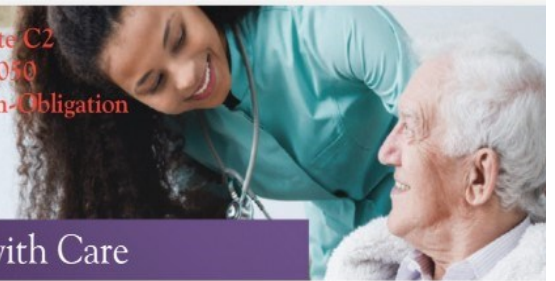
