

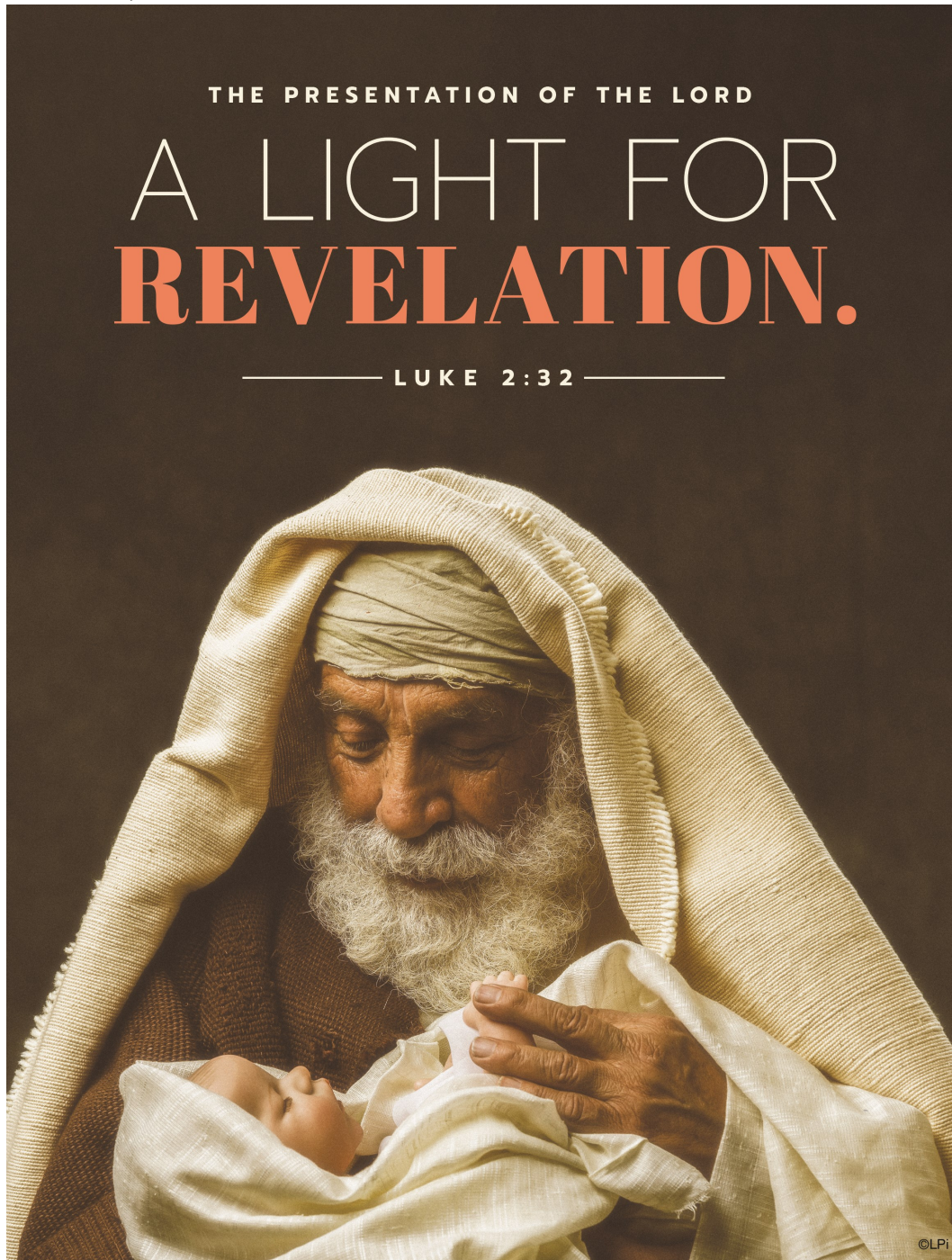

From Monsignor Fran Cilia

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord gives us one more glimpse into the life of the infant Jesus. With it comes the further revelation that His Birth was not for the people of Israel alone, but also for the Gentiles – for the salvation of the whole world.

In our tradition, children are brought to the church for the Sacrament of Baptism. Parents and godparents are given a candle, lighted from the Easter Candle, that each of the newly baptized might share the Light of Christ, in a real and a figurative way. Not only are we to “keep the flame of faith alive” in our hearts, but to be the light of Christ, shared with the world. As we do so, we are to be hope and the living presence of the Lord in the world today.

It may be by coincidence – or divine Providence – that we renew our Annual Diocesan Appeal this weekend. We accomplish the theme set for the Appeal, *Supporting our Mission Together*, by sharing the Light of Christ beyond the boundaries of family, neighborhood and parish. Our outreach is to the wider Church in the Diocese of San José and to all whom we serve here, throughout Santa Clara County and even to the ends of the earth.

I ask each parishioner and family to consider in prayer how you can participate – how you can be part of this joint effort here at Saint Clare. Our success depends upon each of you. Without you, even if we make our financial goal, we will fail, because the ultimate goal is that each of us shares in this work according to our ability to do so.

Our diocesan-assigned goal this year is \$112,063. We have added to this \$87,937, for a total combined goal of \$200,000. If current and past years are any indication, we need to put aside some extra funds for the inevitable repairs that we will need as our facilities continue to age. We cannot afford to continue to go into savings to cover these expenses, or we will deplete our savings faster than we can imagine.

If you cannot give financially, I ask that you pledge your prayers for the success of the ADA in our parish.

Our investment in the implementation of the Pastoral Plan of the Diocese of San José is also an investment in the future of Saint Clare Parish. I thank those who have already made their pledges and gifts and I ask everyone who is reading this to bring to your prayer this request for your support. Thank you.

Boletim Paroquial Português 2 de Fevereiro de 2025 – Solenidade da Apresentação do Senhor Reflexão Por: João Pereira Arruda

Vem esta Solenidade que celebramos neste Domingo salientar o gesto de Maria ir ao Templo apresentar Jesus quarenta dias depois do Seu nascimento. Este gesto de Maria e a sua importância, não passou despercebido à Igreja e, faz uma pequena pausa no Tempo Comum, para celebrar-mos o mistério donde começa o sofrimento e a dor de Maria pelo final de Jesus, que obedecendo ao Pai sofreu morte de Cruz, como penhor dos nossos pecados e salvação da Humanidade. O gesto de Maria, que oferece, traduz-se em gesto litúrgico quando ao celebrarmos a Eucaristia oferecemos os frutos da terra e do trabalho do homem, símbolo da nossa vida.

Nesta página do Boletim Paroquial de Saint Clare também será apresentada uma versão sobre a história da nossa Comunidade Paroquial Portuguesa nesta paróquia. Como foi previamente anunciado, teve lugar no salão paroquial uma apresentação com imagens que falam muito dessa história. Com uma audiência encorajadora, foi realizado um convívio pelo qual a generosidade genuína da nossa comunidade foi realçada nos pratos variados de boa comida com que esta foi partilhada e tornou o convívio mais íntimo e apetitoso. Assim no passado Domingo dia 19 de Janeiro deu-se início a uma variedade de sugestões para que durante todo este ano de 2025 e como comunidade celebremos o Quinquagésimo Aniversário da presença Portuguesa nesta paróquia com serviços litúrgicos em Português. Na Sociedade dos nossos dias tem uma importância muito significativa celebrar cinquenta anos de contínua existência. Aparece este grau de importância; tanto na idade das pessoas, nos casamentos, nas carreiras profissionais, nas organizações e também em comunicações de imigrantes; que é o nosso caso. Por assim ser as actividades, promoções, terão e darão um grau de importância para dar um tom festivo no tudo que como comunidade iremos fazer.

Se fomos a começar a nossa história do princípio os serviços litúrgicos em Português tiveram o seu início na primavera de 1973, e pelo padre Gilberto Avelar. Vindo este do Brasil, donde estava como missionário vindo estudar para as Universidades de Berkley e DE Santa Clara, mais por casualidade do que outra coisa encontrou-se com um grupo de portugueses que se quedaram a conversar em frente da igreja. O padre Gilberto metendo-se na conversa veio depois veio a conhecer que havia muitos portugueses na nossa paróquia. A resposta foi de não termos padre que falasse português. A partir daí o padre Gilberto com algumas pessoas que estavam a conversar em frente da nossa Igreja formaram uma comissão para conseguir um sacerdote ser a nossa comunidade em todos os serviços litúrgicos. A partir daí e até Setembro de 1975 (data em que ficou oficialmente um sacerdote que falasse Português e Espanhol para servir as comunidades Portuguesas e Hispânicas. Padre José Ribeiro chegou assim a Santa Clara, este arregaçando as mangas começou desde o seu início entre nós a formar leigos para muitos ministérios. Deu-se também ao cuidado de nos realizar-mos como comunidade formando o Conselho Paroquial Português seria prioritariamente servir de elo de ligação entre a comunidade da paróquia, entre as Organizações Portuguesas de Santa Clara e o Pastor. E, nem tudo foi fácil, mas tal como quando se celebra cinquenta anos de casados não são celebrados só os abraços e beijos mas o Sacramento do Matrimónio no seu todo tempo de desafio, tristezas, dores, faltas mas mais ainda o amor que alimenta a união do casal que aposta no amor do Sacramento assim também estamos a celebrar a nossa comunidade e nela celebrar a nossa família em unidade e amor fraterno.

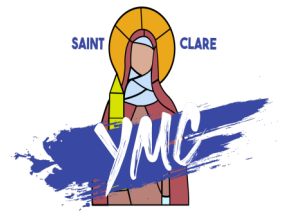

Sus donaciones son una señal de nuestra solidaridad con nuestros vecinos del sur.

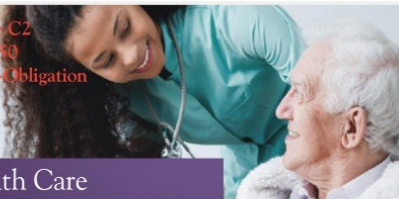
Primera Reconciliación
