From Monsignor Fran Cilia

Pope Francis has designated this Sunday as “Sunday of the Word of God,” with the intent to enkindle within all of us a greater love and appreciation of God’s word, as found in the Old Testament and the New Testament.

Many of us do not know about the Bible, except what we hear at Mass. One of the reasons that the Liturgy of the Word was expanded in the reforms of the Second Vatican Council was to bring Catholics into contact in greater depth with the contents of the Bible. And this was done to whet our appetite for wanting to hear God’s word on a deeper level. We remember the words of Saint Jerome that “Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ.”

The Lord speaks to us through His word; we come to know Him more and more the longer we sit and pray with the Scriptures. This year, we will be focusing on the Gospel of Saint Luke at our Sunday liturgies. For those who have not made a habit of reading from the Bible, I might suggest that you open Luke’s gospel (it is the third book of the New Testament, about two-thirds the way through the Bible). Be sure you have a Bible with footnotes and explanations. These can be a great help to understand what you are reading. And remember that the entirety of the Bible was written thousands of years ago and in languages unlike any that we currently speak.

As the inspired word of God, it is actually God who is speaking to us, with the help of the human authors. I invite you to open your minds and hearts to the Lord’s word or, more precisely, to the Lord Himself Whose shares with us His holy word.

Thank you for your gifts toward this weekend’s collection for the Church in Latin America. Your generosity goes a long way in supporting the work of various dioceses and religious orders who serve a large majority of the population in Central and South America.

As we prepare to renew our efforts for Annual Diocesan Appeal, Saint Clare’s performance in recent years’ ADA makes it clear that success is already within our reach.

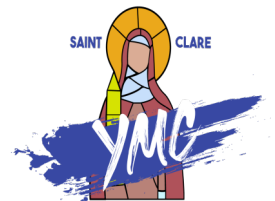

Join us for our youth ministry Sundays this week on Sunday, Jan 26th, at 1:30pm in the parish hall. All 8th-12th graders are invited.

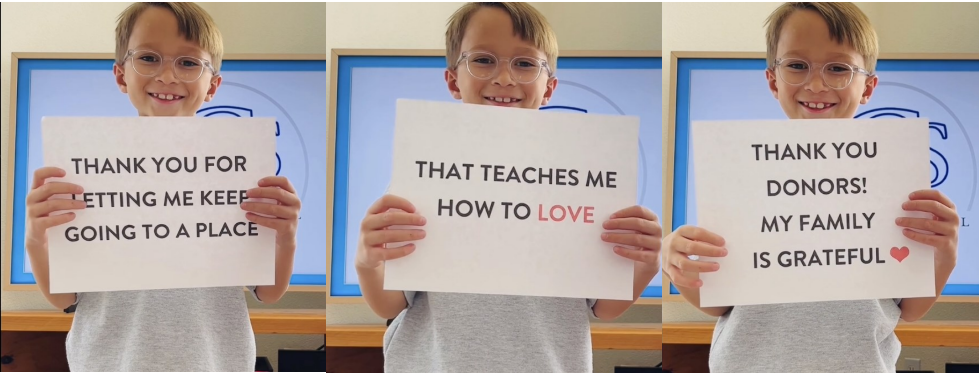

Muchos de nosotros no sabemos acerca de la Biblia, excepto lo que escuchamos en la Misa. 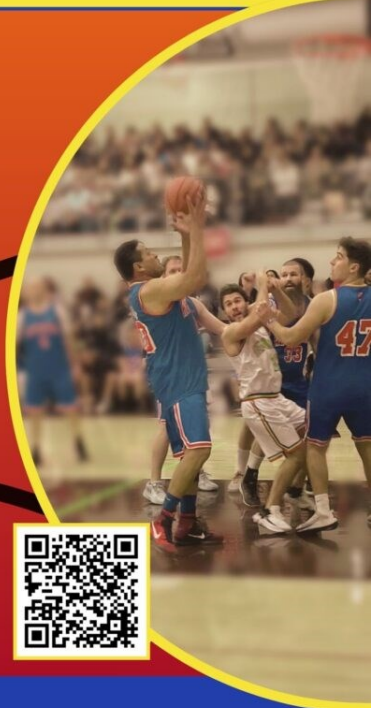

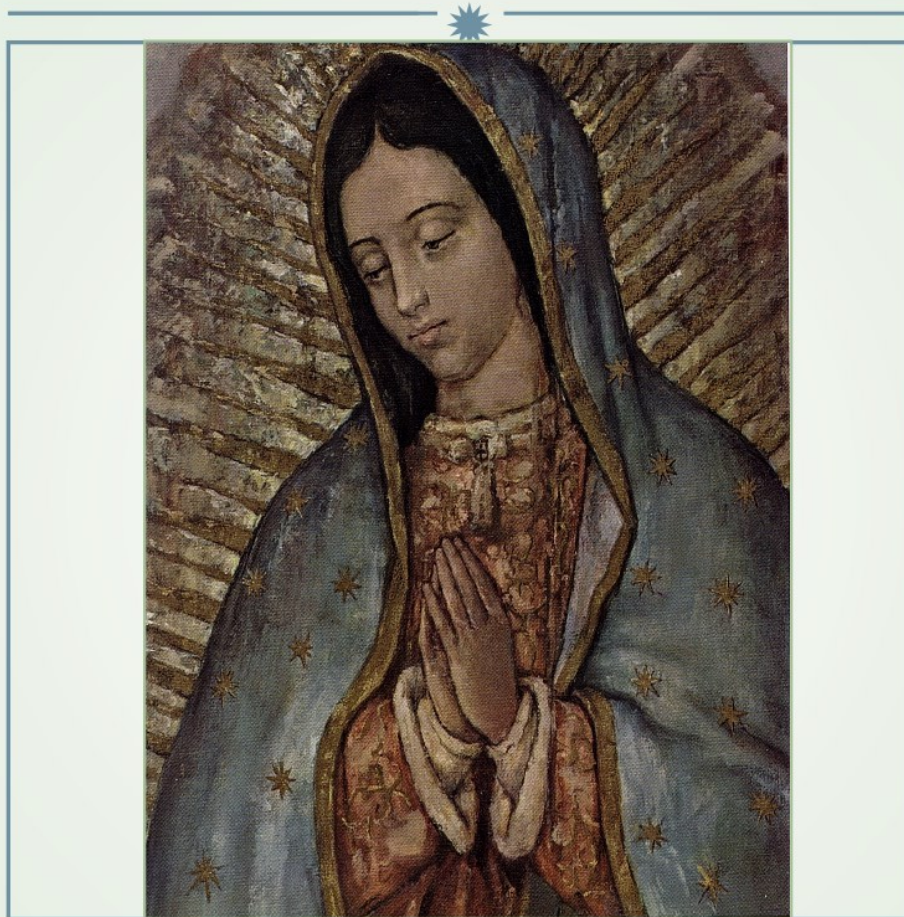

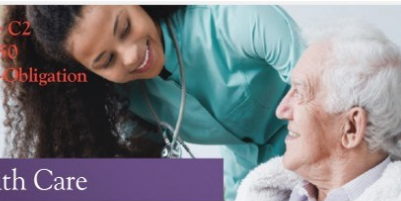
