

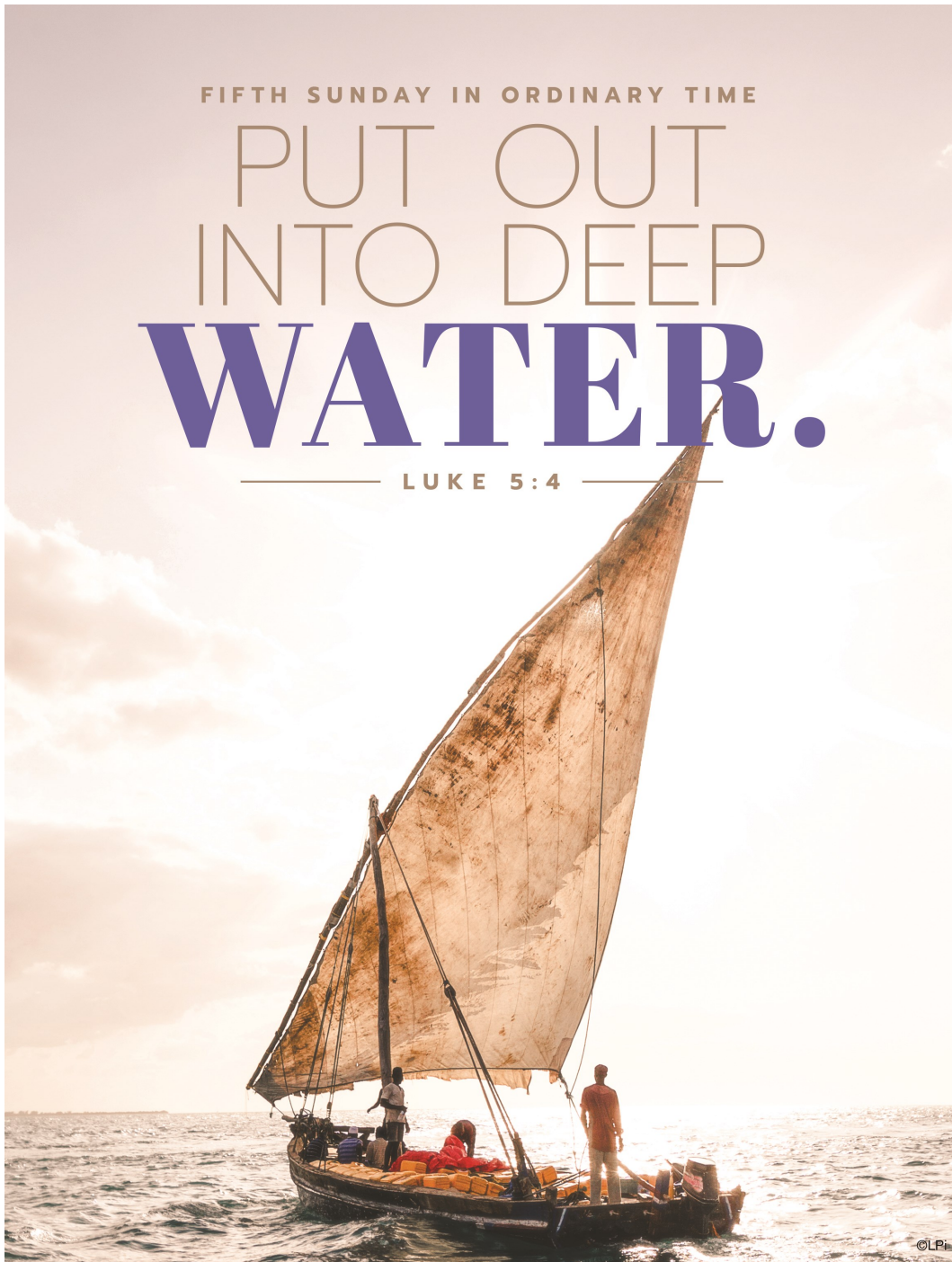

It is more likely that we would find it difficult to change the ways that we are comfortable in terms of our temperament and our attitudes, preconceived notions and uninformed (or informed) opinions.

Those who gave up everything were radical, or extreme, followers of the Lord. Over the millennia, they have been joined by others, including Saints Francis and Clare of Assisi, Saint Dominic, Saint Ignatius of Loyola and Mother Theresa of Calcutta, just to name a few.

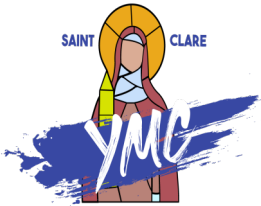
Boletim Paroquial Português **9 de Fevereiro de 2025 – Domingo V do Tempo Comum – C** **Dia Mundial do Matrimônio e da para honrar a vida consagrada ao Senhor** **Reflexão Por: João Pereira Arruda**

A Igreja dedica este Domingo á vida consagrada e ao Sacramento do Matrimônio. Tanto na vida consagrada ao Senhor, como na vida de um casal exige que haja fidelidade, dedicação e entrega de vidas ao Senhor. As leituras deste Domingo dão apoio a estas virtudes de entrega de vida, seja esta dedicada inteiramente ao Senhor, seja esta dedicada aos esposos e a Cristo; como é o caso de um casamento sólido. Enquanto os esposos usam o sacramento do Matrimônio para apoiar e alimentar o seu relacionamento um com o outro e os dois unidos com Cristo, assim também, os que decidem consagrar-se a Cristo e á sua Igreja, também decisão de consagração é alimentada pelo Espírito Santo de Deus em focarem suas vidas ao serviço do povo de Deus, dando continuidade ao que Cristo deu de graça aos Apóstolos. Seja na consagração de vida ou no casal que se casa pelo sacramento do matrimônio tem que aceitar e ter Jesus Cristo no meio da decisão e do acordo que fizeram nas suas decisoes de seguirem Cristo.

Neste ano em que, como comunidade, estamos a celebrar o quinquagésimo aniversário da nossa presença com missa e serviços litúrgicos em português iniciamos a celebrar este Domingo dedicado ao Sacramento do Matrimônio em 1985. Os fins de semana do Encontro Matrimonial começaram a crescer com uma iniciativa do casal Manuel e Diane Madruga, quatro casais fizeram seu fim de semana em Junho de 1982 e em inglês. Foi a partir daí que começou a germinar a ideia na cabeça do casal Madruga que estes fins de semana dedicados a fazer o amor crescer nos casais seria benifical para os casais portugueses na California e foi de uma equipa mista de casais da comunidade Paroquial Portuguesa de Santa Clara com mais dois casais da comunidade portuguesa de Newark que se realizou o primeiro fim de semana em português. Este Movimento teve uma durabilidade de aproximadamente dez anos e por toda a Califórnia, em particular nos locais que têm mais portugueses que várias equipas executivas; essas compostas por três casais e um sacerdote doarem-se generosamente a darem as palestras (charlas) em vários locais de retiros ou hotéis. Fosse os lugares em Three Rivers, Santa Nella, Turlock ou Santa Cruz os casais da equipa, deixavam os filhos ao cuidado dos familiares ou amigos e lá iam na maioria dos casos para verem a felecidade retratada cheia de emoção nos finais dos encontros. Este Movimento continua a existir em inglês e o nosso boletim paroquial dá informação sobre o como este é dado. Os círculos de amor cessaram mas enquanto eram feitos providenciavam certos efeitos positivos de crescimento no relacionamento do casal e no seu amor entre si e por Jesus Cristo. Aprende-se que um casal que se casa não é só os conjuges dizerem sim um ao outro, mas só também receber Cristo porque é o amor de Cristo que alimenta o amor do casal ... um pelo outro e pelos filhos. Esta celebração não deve ser uma celebração qualquer, celebrando este dia dedicado ao Sacramento do Matrimônio é também lembrar uma era que gerou grande entusiasmo e participação dos nossos casais no Movimento do encontro Matrimonial em Português. O único congresso feito para os casais que tinha feito fins de semana foi liderado pelo Padre José Ribeiro, e um casal vindo do Continente Português e o casal Madruga em San Leandro. Quarenta anos depois ainda se recorda com um misto de saudade aqueles fins de semana que faziam dar entendimento ao casal que pelo sacramento do matrimônio o casal quando é uma trindade são três num só: Jesus Cristo é o Elo que liga o ANEL!

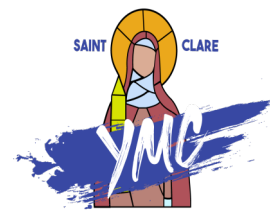

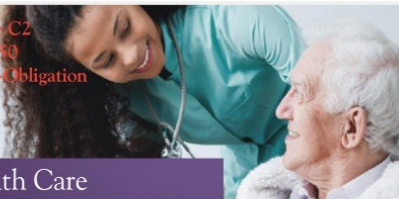
Cena de Cangrejo de los Caballeros de Colón ~ 15 de febrero
