

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## From Monsignor Fran Cilia

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Writing to the Church at Philippi, Saint Paul offered this hope:

He will change our lowly body to conform with his glorified body by the power that enables him also to bring all things into subjection to himself.

Therefore, my brothers and sisters, whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, in this way stand firm in the Lord.

On this Second Sunday of Lent, we hear an account of the Lord's Transfiguration. It gave His companions, Peter, James and John, a foreshadowing of Jesus' ultimate triumph over sin and death, which they did not understand, as they did not yet comprehend what it would be to rise from the dead.

For Jesus, the Transfiguration, coming as it does after the first prediction of His Passion, offers consolation and the continued assurance that the Father did not abandon Him.

As we celebrate the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick at Masses this weekend, the Lord offers the same hope, which He and the apostles received on the Mount of Transfiguration, to our sisters and brothers who suffer from illness or the frailty of age. Whether or not the Sacrament effects physical healing, it offers the hope of a healing of spirit, a remedy to the isolation that is the experience of many who are ill and often isolated.

In this Sacrament, the entire community of faith stands with those who come forward to be anointed. We pray for them and offer the support of those prayers to assure our weaker brothers and sisters that they are not alone.

The formula that is recited by the priest as each person is anointed gives an insight into the purpose of the anointing:

*Through this holy anointing, may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit. Amen.*

*May the Lord who frees you from sin save you and raise you up. Amen*

## Annual Diocesan Appeal: Week 6

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You continue to get us closer to our combined goal of \$200,000 ! Thank you. This past week has seen a few larger gifts, which helped propel us over our diocesan goal (\$112,063). As of Sunday evening, we were at almost \$130,000, from 185 donors.

Many thanks to all who have contributed – according to your means.

We still need more to come forward, with the realization that whatever is raised above our diocesan goal will help the parish in the budgeting process for the coming fiscal year (July 2025-June 2026). Every bit helps.

As we have said in the past, we are not asking for **equal gifts**, but for **equal sacrifice**. Until every household does its fair part of this effort, it will not be a success, for success is not counted only on the amount raised, but by the extent to which we all pitch in to make this possible.

That less than 200 families and households have taken part from the more than 900 that are registered is a sad commentary. We cannot let “them” do the work that belongs to “all of us.”

Please do whatever you can so that we can complete this year's ADA long before we enter Holy Week – Palm Sunday is April 13. Thank you, all.

**Reflexão Por: João Pereira Arruda**

A Transfiguração de Jesus é um momento de comunhão entre Ele e Deus. No Tabor, a transfiguração revela o mistério da sua crucificação e glorificação futura, mostrando a manifestação de Deus. A presença de Moisés e Elias juntamente com Jesus, representa a totalidade da revelação do Antigo Testamento com a Lei e os Profetas. Tanto Elias como Moisés tiveram enquanto vivos encontros com Deus no Monte do Sinai e agora com Jesus como mensageiro de Deus. Assim como o Tabor marcou os corações de Pedro, Tiago e João, também somos convidados a experimentar a beleza e a alegria da transfiguração de Jesus. A transfiguração mostra-nos que a vida da cruz conduz-nos à glória, e que a visão de Cristo transfigurado revela, não apenas a Sua divindade mas também o esplendor final de cada crente redimido na cruz de Cristo. A transfiguração de Jesus aponta para a ressurreição como o fim do nosso caminho, uma antecipação da Páscoa. Assim como os Apóstolos viram a glória de Jesus, somos chamados a aceitar a cruz diariamente e a seguir-Lo até ao fim. Não se chega à glória sem passar pela cruz. A voz do Pai celeste valida Jesus como o Seu Filho amado, motivando-nos a seguir o caminho cristão, fé e generosidade. A Voz do Pai proclama Jesus como a Palavra a ser ouvida. É essencial escutar Jesus para viver para viver a Sua mensagem de salvação. Ao seguir-Lo, seguimos o caminho da verdade que leva a vida eterna.

**Continuando com o historial do quinquagésimo aniversário da Comunidade Paroquial Portuguesa na paróquia de Saint Clare's e depois do padre Meira regressar a Portugal, João Arruda recebeu instruções de fazer o planeamento desta devoção. Por este tempo já se fazia as estações nas línguas: inglês, Português, Espanhol e mandarim. Criou-se um sistema rotativo para cada estação ser feita nesta quatro línguas, por ser muito longa mudou-se para um sistema de todas as estações serem feitas em inglês e numa outra das restantes três línguas. Ainda no tempo do padre Meira a Sociedade Filarmónica União Portuguesa de Santa Clara começou a dar mais dignidade com a sua música apropriada para as procissões do Senhor dos Passos ou as do Enterro do Senhor que se faziam nos Açores o que ainda acrescentava mais gente a esta procissão. Também com a vida do último pastor jesuíta padre John Martin que autorizou que o Crucifixo grande saísse em procissão. Esta intervenção do pastor foi muito bem aceite pela multidão que era monitorizada por leigos da nossa comunidade que zelosamente os que a carregavam essa cruz num andor especialmente feita para essa cruz eram mudados em cada estação. Infelizmente por queixas feitas por residentes no giro do caminho que envolve a Mission Library tivemos que criar espaço para que esta devoção continua a ser feita todas as Sextas Feiras Santas. Certo é que através de todos esses anos a nossa comunidade Paroquial tem estado activamente na promoção desta devoção e tem se adaptado às instruções de cada pastor que vem servir a nossa paróquia porque o essencial é dar continuidade a esta devoção muito apropriada do Tríduo Pascal e muito querida da nossa comunidade que vê nesta devoção um meio de acompanhar Jesus na sua paixão e no Seu caminhar com a cruz às costas. Essa devoção dá a cada um de nós de ponderar o imenso amor de Jesus Cristo por cada um de nós que sofreu e teve morte de cruz para nos remir do pecado. (Mais em próximos boletins)**

- **DO NOT ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS** from an immigration agent if they try to talk to you. You have the right to remain silent.
- **DO NOT SIGN ANYTHING** without first speaking to a lawyer. You have the right to speak with a lawyer.
- If you are outside of your home, ask the agent if you are free to leave and if they say yes, leave calmly.
- **GIVE THIS CARD TO THE AGENT.** If you are inside of your home, show the card through the window or slide it under the door.

## De Monseñor Fran Cilia

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Escribiendo a la Iglesia de Filipos, San Pablo ofreció esta esperanza:

Él transformará nuestro cuerpo de humillación en un cuerpo glorioso suyo, mediante el poder que le permite también someter todas las cosas a sí mismo.

Por tanto, hermanos míos, a quienes amo y anhelo, mi alegría y mi corona, permanezcan así firmes en el Señor.

En este segundo domingo de Cuaresma, escuchamos el relato de la Transfiguración del Señor. Para Jesús, la Transfiguración, al ocurrir después de la primera predicción de su Pasión, ofrece consuelo y la certeza constante de que el Padre no lo abandonó.

Al celebrar el Sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos en las Misas de este fin de semana, el Señor ofrece la misma esperanza que Él y los apóstoles recibieron en el Monte de la Transfiguración a nuestros hermanos y hermanas que sufren enfermedades o la fragilidad de la edad. Independientemente de si el Sacramento produce sanación física o no, ofrece la esperanza de una sanación espiritual, un remedio al aislamiento que experimentan muchos enfermos y a menudo aislados.

En este Sacramento, toda la comunidad de fe acompaña a quienes se acercan para ser ungidos. Oramos por ellos y ofrecemos el apoyo de esas oraciones para asegurarles a nuestros hermanos y hermanas más débiles que no están solos.

La fórmula que recita el sacerdote al ungir a cada persona da una idea del propósito de la unción:

*Por esta santa unción y por su bondadosa misericordia,  
te ayude el Señor con la gracia del Espíritu Santo. Amén.*

*Para que, libre de tus pecados  
te conceda la consolación y te conforte in tu enfermedad. Amén.*
